100% pass rate among fourth Semester B.Sc. Nursing students in University Examination.


GENEROUS SUPPORT FROM ALUMNI ASSOCIATION FOR MS. HARSHA


ALUMNI MEET - 2024

COLLEGE DAY - 2024




THE FOOD FEST TOGETHER -2025


